Executive Director's Report

- Executive Director Erich Martens thanked board members and staff for attending the NFHS Summer Meeting in Chicago.
- Recognized Minnesota native and NFHS Hall of Fame inductee Carrie Tollefson on her excellent acceptance speech.
- Thanked the MSHSL staff and incoming board members for participating in the board orientation in early July.
- Shared information that a Casey's Convenience Store is planned for the vacant lot on Freeway Boulevard across from the League Office.
- Shared that Associate Director Craig Perry has been selected for a four-year term as chairman of the NFHS Ice Hockey Rules Committee.
- Thanked Assistant Director Chris Franson for his years of service with the League and discussed the process for hiring a replacement.
- The appointment of the 20th board position, a Governor Appointee, is being finalized.
- Thanked the board and staff members for their participation in the workshop.

Executive Committee Report

- Reviewed information provided by the Football Advisory Committee from the schools in 6A football regarding section assignments and district assignments. Directed staff to connect with the District Football Placement Committee for background and recommendations.
- Reviewed the current discussions regarding streaming of tournaments with School Space Media. Supported ongoing discussions and agreements to maintain or grow the number of tournaments that are streamed.
- Discussed the merits of the Board Workshop process and directed staff to commence planning for future workshops at the same, or like, venues.
